# **Library Geography Programme**



## **PrePrimary - Geography – People Live in Places**

**Students learn:**

- **About the places people live in and belong to and the familiar features in the local area and why places are important to people.**

## **Year One - Geography - Places have distinctive features**

**Students learn:**

- **About the activities that take place in the local community which create its distinctive features.**

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**Year Two - People are connected to many places**

**Students learn:**

- **about the influence of purpose, distance and accessibility on the frequency with which people visit places.**

**Year Three - Places are both similar and different**

**Students learn:**

- **the difference between climate and weather, the main climatic zones of world and the similarities and differences between the climates of different places.**

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**Year Four - The Earth's environment sustains all life**

**Students learn:**

- **about Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples ways of living were adapted to available resources and their connection to Country/Place has influenced their views on the sustainable use of these resources, before and after colonisation.**

**Year Five - Factors that shape the environmental characteristics of places**

**Students learn:**

- **about features of the environments that influence human activities and the built features of places.**
